St. Aloysius collects **Box Tops for Education**<sup>®</sup>. We receive \$0.10 per Box Top turned into St. Aloysius School. Box Tops appear on many products that you purchase each month. Look for **Box Tops for Education**<sup>®</sup> on Cereal, Annie's products, Green Giant products, El Paso products, Hefty products, select Kleenex tissue boxes with an overwrap, Land O' Lakes products, Lysol products, Nature Valley products, Reynold's bakeware, Scott paper products, Yoplait, and Ziploc products. See the attached sheet for the current listing.

Please keep in mind that **Box Tops for Education**<sup>®</sup> have an expiration date printed on each box top. Please turn them in timely to the School Office. Every Box Top counts.

Look for a **Bonus Box Tops Certificate**, a physical certificate printed or stickered on the package purchased in a store during a special offer. These certificates must be turned into the St. Aloysius School Office for submission by the School Coordinator before their expiration date.

## Coca-Cola Give (New Program)

**Coca-Cola Give** is a new program from The Coca-Cola Company for donating to local schools and charities. The Coca-Cola Company issues cash payments quarterly to schools and charities to be used for physical education, sports, technology, and/or, arts programs.

To get started, visit <https://us.coca-cola.com/give/schools/> and create a profile. Search for St. Aloysius School – Pewee Valley (zip code 40056) so we receive credit for the codes that you enter. Then, enter codes from caps and/or packaging to donate to our St. Aloysius School.

It is easy! You enter your codes from anywhere using your computer or mobile device. There is no need to send anything to the school. You can even get the kids to enter codes.

Any Coca-Cola beverage that has a product code under its cap is eligible to be used for donation. Eligible codes are also printed on the inside surface of cardboard packaging for 12, 20, and 24-packs of cans.

Each participating Cola-Cola brand bottle cap earns St. Aloysius \$0.05. Codes from 12-packs of cans earn \$0.15; codes from 20-packs of cans earn \$0.27; and codes from 24-packs of cans earn \$0.30. Entering Coca-Cola codes adds up quickly!

### Kroger Community Rewards

Kroger is committed to helping our communities grow and prosper. Year after year, local schools, churches and other nonprofit organizations earn millions of dollars through Kroger Community Rewards. Select St. Aloysius PTO (organization number 10049, zip code 40056), and Kroger will donate a percentage of your purchases to St. Aloysius every time you swipe your Kroger Plus Card. It is easy!



### Recycle Aluminum Cans at St. Aloysius



Do you have aluminum cans that you throw in the trash or recycle curbside? Consider recycling them through St. Aloysius. The Student Council's Recycling Committee coordinates the aluminum can recycling center during the school year. Proceeds from the recycling program go to school-related and Student Council programs.

Aluminum cans may be dropped off anytime in the recycling center. This is another easy way to support St. Aloysius.

Where is the St. Aloysius recycling center? Look for the garage behind the Chapel. Standing between the garage and the Chapel and looking toward the school, you will see the recycling center on the left under the stairs coming from the Middle School wing.

### Percentage Nights at Nearby Restaurants

Periodically, the PTO will work with a nearby restaurant to sponsor a percentage day or night. The restaurant will donate a portion of your food expenses to St. Aloysius if you show a flyer provided by the PTO. Look for announcements of upcoming Percentage Nights on the School website and on the PTO Facebook Page.

### Used Uniforms

Donate used St. Aloysius School uniforms and spirit wear to the School Office. Items are sold for \$4 per item, and the proceeds support the activities of the PTO for the benefit of St. Aloysius School.
