

Middle School Governor's Cup

Governor's Cup is a statewide academic competition that our school participates in each year. We have two levels: Elementary (grades 4 & 5) and Middle School (grades 6,7 & 8). Practice team participation is open to ALL students. Students may practice with as many teams as they wish, but only 3 for each subject area will be chosen to actually go to the competition. This is a tiered competition, so students may advance to regional contests based on their performance.

To prepare in the areas of Language Arts, Arts & Humanities, Math, Science, and Social Studies students will take practice tests, go over vocabulary and review topics covered on the tests in order to help them be successful on the final test for the specific subject area. Students participating in English Composition will practice writing persuasive pieces. The day of the competition, students will be given a topic and write an on demand persuasive paper. Quick Recall teams are determined by their coaches.

Please encourage students to practice on teams as their interests/time allows. Being a part of the practice team is an honor and a wonderful opportunity to learn more about a particular subject.
